

Wapiti Meadow Ranch Work Weekend
June 21 and 22, 2008

Meals: Dinner on Friday will be grilled outside with food provided by the chapter and potluck by club members.

1. Hamburgers and chicken breasts to grill, buns, paper ware, and soft drinks will be provided by the chapter
2. Salads, appetizers, condiments, vegetables, and desserts – there will be a side dish assignment sheet made up once we know who is coming
3. Diana will make a pot of beans
4. You are welcome to supply your own beer and wine (or White Cloud Surprise)

Breakfasts on both Saturday and Sunday will be provided by the Ranch, lunches will be on your own, Saturday for dinner we will all be guests of the Ranch.

Accommodations: Those of us with campers, living quarter trailers and tents should plan to bring them. Parking for campers will be marked. There will be limited space to share in cabins (solo women and the lame will have priority) and unlimited space for tents.

Stock containment: Plan to high line your stock or bring electric corrals or panels. Bring grazing or picket hobbles if you use them.

Forage and water: Phil will bring ten bales of our club weed free hay. Stock can be watered in the creek or in your own container. Sign up to bring more hay.

We will most likely break into up to four work parties, chain saws will be needed for each. At this time it looks as if we will be working on access to trails and the lower elevations due to snow conditions.

Commitment: A hard and fast commitment must be made by June 5 so that adequate supplies can be purchased, van/trailer pools can be arranged, and the work parties will have appropriate gear.

Arrival and Departure: We are welcome to arrive Thursday and leave Monday, but it will be camping only on those days and Diana will need a head count.
