

CPR & Wilderness First Aid Refresher Course



The Bogus Basin Ski Patrol is a mostly volunteer organization that primarily provides support for the Bogus Basin Mountain Resort nonprofit organization that is entrusted with the stewardship of the ski area by the U.S. Forest Service. The support we provide is emergency first aid services. We respond, assess, treat, package, and transport to higher medical authority.

Squaw Butte has contacted and made arrangements with the Bogus Ski Patrol to hold a CPR and Wilderness First Aid refresher course. This course will be very hands on and taught by the same EMT that teaches the patroller each year. They agreed to do this course because BCHI is also a nonprofit volunteer service organization.

The course is one day and is best for members who have attended a first aid course in the past, although everyone will leave at the end of the day with a saddle bag full of knowledge and more confidence.
