

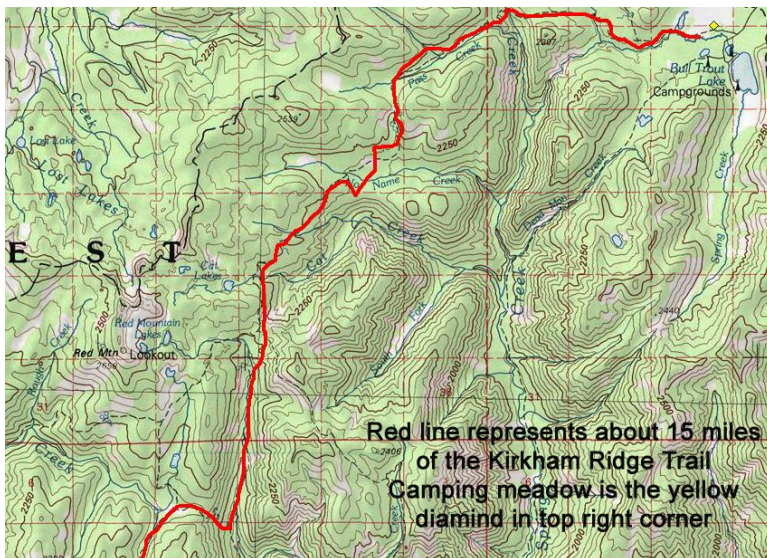
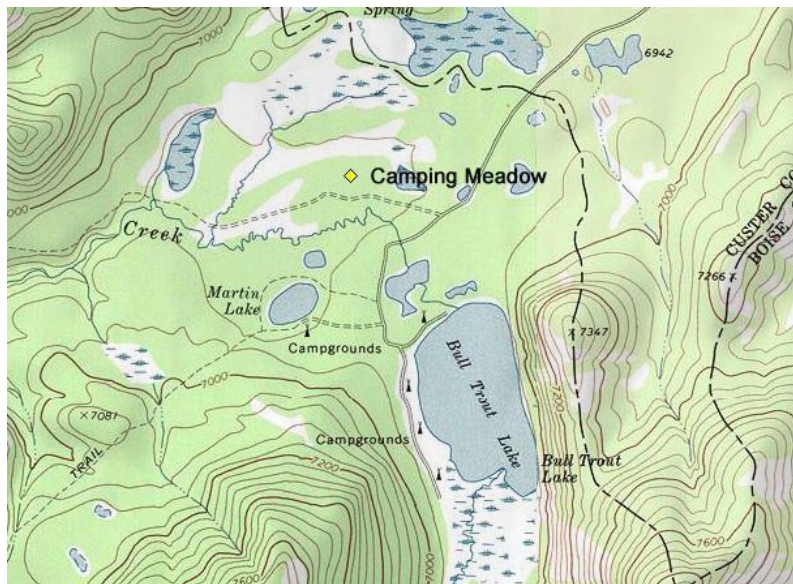
# Directions to Bull Trout Lake

**Distance from Emmett:** Approximately 107 miles, 2.5 hours travel time Drive from Emmett Lowman, from Lowman go 34 miles northeast on ID 21; Turn left onto Bull Trout Lake Road for approximately 2 miles

**Description:** 6900-foot elevation. 19 campsites on Bull Trout Lake. Campground includes 28 single family sites, 6 double sites (16 people), and two group sites which can accommodate up to 50 people each. Many of the sites, including the group areas, are handicapped-accessible. 2 single sites and 2 double sites have horse facilities. A few of the single sites are first come, first served, but the rest are reservable.

Trailhead at campground accesses a far-ranging trail system running north and south. Wheelchair-accessible (sites 35-38) and group equestrian camping facilities available, with corrals in camp sites.

As a group we usually camp in a meadow north of the campground proper. There is a dirt road to the right just before you get to the horse camping facilities. (See images below)
